V. APPLICANT SIGNATURE

Section 23a of the State Construction Code Act of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523A, as amended by 1999 PA 245, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential structure. Violators of Section 23a are subjected to civil fines.

VIIa. FEE CLARIFICATION

ITEM #2, MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE: When item is used for sewer excavation in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee plus the number of unit sites. When setting a mobile home in a park, or a mobile or modular home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water service or water distribution pipe.

IX. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Keweenaw County Building Department. All installations shall be in conformance with the Plumbing Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. A NEW HOME requires 3 inspections: Underground, Rough & Final. The inspector will need the job location and permit number. If you have any questions, please contact the following inspector:

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND/OR CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.**
