BIRTH RECORDS: 1867 to present

The Keweenaw County Clerk's office has birth records for individuals born in Keweenaw County ONLY. Birth records are restricted in Michigan and an individual is only entitled to their own or their child's birth record (must be named on the birth record). If records are more than 100 years old, access may be gained. Photo ID is required when requesting a birth record.

The following information is required on your request or download request form.

- -Full name at birth
- -Date of birth

-Parent's names (including mother's maiden name)

- -Place of birth
- -Signature

-An identifying document (copy of driver's license, state ID card, etc)

-Return address and daytime phone number

DEATH RECORDS: 1867 to present

The Keweenaw County Clerk's office has death records for persons whose death occurred in Keweenaw County ONLY. If the decedent was a resident in Keweenaw County but died outside of Keweenaw County, you will need to contact the county where the death occurred to obtain a copy of the death record. Death certificates are public records and can be obtained by anyone.

The following information is required on your request or download request form.

- -Name of decedent
- -Date of death
- -Signature
- -Return address and daytime phone number

-Fee for certified copy (check or money order) payable to: Keweenaw County Clerk

MARRIAGE RECORDS: 1867 to present

The Keweenaw County Clerk's office has marriage records for individuals who were residents of the county and made application for the license in Keweenaw County at the time in which they were married. There are also records for individuals that were out-of-state residents who were married in Keweenaw County.

The following information is required on your request or download request form.

- -Name of each person
- -Maiden name (if applicable)
- -Date of marriage
- -Signature
- -Return address and daytime phone number
- -Fee for certified copy (check or money order) payable to: Keweenaw County Clerk

Certified copies are \$10 for the first copy and \$3 for each additional copy.
