Keweenaw County Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for Engineering Services

Keweenaw County is seeking professional engineering/architectural services for the design of the Keweenaw County Emergency Operations Center (KCEOC). The County has received a \$50,000 grant through the Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity's Office of Rural Prosperity to initiate this preliminary engineering. The scope of services for the project will include:

A. Scope of Services:

- Site Evaluation shall include the following:
 - o Evaluation of adequacy of existing utility infrastructure to support proposed facility needs.
 - o Property location information will be made available to the Consultant
 - o Consultant shall make their own determinations on the need for additional survey, topography, or soil borings, etc., to complete the required scope of services being requested.
- Quantity of initial meetings required; a minimum of 4 meetings, one of which will be a public meeting.
 Please note that administrative/facilitation of these meetings will be provided by the KCEOC planning committee.
- Minimum Preliminary Design/Design Development deliverables shall include a minimum of the following:
 - o Three (3) (mass timber, CMU, steel) options for building construction material type and corresponding cost estimates for each, including costs for plumbing, electrical, mechanical, HVAC, fire suppression (if needed), etc.
 - o Proposed Facility Floor Plan, Elevations and Building Sections
 - o Preparation of conceptual site plan (at least 50% design), proposed utility services and preliminary site construction cost estimates completed by February 1, 2025 to include:
 - Facility/building design shall accommodate necessary County equipment storage;
 - o Facility design for all County essential and emergency service trainings;
 - o An Emergency Operations Center/Meeting Center for large scale emergency response and coordination.
 - Further information from the KCEOC Building Subcommittee and Programming Subcommittee will be provided to Consultant to guide overall facility design. Information to be provided to the Consultant by mid-summer 2024.

B. Statement of Qualifications Submittal Requirements

- 1. Respondents: name, address, telephone number and federal tax identification number.
- 2. Name, title, address, telephone number, and email address of contact person authorized to contractually obligate the Respondent.
- 3. A brief history of the firm including engineering/architectural qualifications, year of incorporation, and location of office(s) relative to the project.
- 4. A list of key personnel proposed for the project team including resumes.
- 5. A list of references with contact information.
- 6. Proof of professional liability insurance.
- 7. Provide outline of firms and project managers experience on similar work and experience related to scope of work listed in this proposal.
- 8. Firm's knowledge and work history with Keweenaw County and/or within the region.
- 9. Timeline of proposed project completion by deadline.
- 10. Demonstrate past experience with Government projects in terms of cost control, quality of work and compliance with performance schedules.

- 11. Provide any experience with use of mass timber products. Provide relevant examples if applicable. *This experience may be required.
- 12. Explain if you will provide any in-kind services towards this community driven project.
- 13. Provide a description of your experience and approach to working collaboratively with a diverse community stakeholder group during this planning process.
- 14. Proposed Fee for the Scope of Services defined in Section A.

C. <u>Selection Criteria</u>

Keweenaw County and the KCEOC RFP Sub-Committee shall evaluate each potential firm in terms on its:

- 1. Proposed Fee; 36 points
- 2. Professional qualifications necessary for satisfactory performance of required services; 30 points
- 3. Specialized experience and technical competence in the type of work required; 27 points
- 4. Past performance on contracts with Government agencies in terms of cost control, quality of work, and compliance with performance schedules; **27 points**
- 5. Capacity to accomplish the work in the required time; 24 points
- 6. Demonstrate knowledge of and intent of the project; 18 points
- 7. Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively with community stakeholder committees; 18 points
- 8. Previous experience with mass timber products; 12 points
- 9. Willingness to provide in-kind/donation of support; 9 points
