A special meeting of the Keweenaw County Board of Commissioners held with ZOOM being available due to COVID 19 on July 23, 2020 beginning at 10:00 a.m., at the Courthouse, Eagle River, MI and began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The special meeting was posted on the door of the Courthouse and on the County website. Due to COVID 19, the Zoom information was posted on the website which allowed the anyone to attend virtually.

Commissioners present: Bob DeMarois, Sandy Gayk, Jim Vivian, Don Piche. Del Rajala via Zoom.

The meeting was called to discuss the Juvenile Officer/Probate Register position. Due to the coronavirus, Kermit's Keweenaw Kids is not operating at its full potential which led to the Juvenile Officer being put on furlough. A special meeting was held on June 2, 2020 to make the determination and the Juvenile Officer began furlough on June 8, 2020. This meeting is being held to discuss if this is working out and if it should continue.

The Juvenile Officer is willing to continue with this current plan of working two days per week and continuing on unemployment until the end of August.

Motion by Gayk supported by Rajala and unanimously carried to table this until the end of August and asked that the Juvenile Officer come back before the Board at that time with a plan for moving forward.
