- Brownfield Redevelopment Authority: David Sundberg
 - Property ownership issues continue to be explored. Ground water contamination issues in Keweenaw County are must be addressed.
 Contaminated water negates development. USAF must be held accountable.
 - o Brownfield Authority will sponsor a dinner meeting and presentation at the Mountain Lodge in May, 2010. Business leaders and entrepreneurs are being contacted. Purpose of meeting is to develop ideas for potential uses and partners for the Mt. Horace Greeley Airbase site in order to encourage the US Government to support Brownfield investigation and potential grants of land and activity. Requested EDC input to identify business leaders and entrepreneurs.
 - Keweenaw County waste transfer station being investigated. Site requirements include access to a water system and a centralized location.

• GRANT AVAILABILITY: Tom O'Callaghan

o To date, research on grant availability for small businesses indicate Federal grants are rare or non-existent. State grants focus on low interest loans or

minority ownership.
