GUEST SPEAKERS:

Michael D. Erdman, PhD, District Coordinator, Michigan State University Extension Services

Julie Melchiori, County Extension/EDC Coordinator/Greening Michigan Institute of MSU

MSU Extension Services have restructured with a focus of economic development in the state. Business and entrepreneurial development, sustainable tourism, new venture and innovation counseling including natural resource, green energy and food business enterprise education services are available.

Kim Stoker, Executive Director, Western Upper Peninsula Planning & Development Region

Stoker presented a proposal to supplement a \$50,000.00 feasibility study, (one half of the cost will be paid by the State and Stoker is requesting \$12,500 each from Keweenaw and Houghton Counties) for the potential creation of a facility which would utilize stamp sands to manufacture various building products.

- ➤ Due to copper content, stamp sands are a natural mold inhibitor ideal for the manufacture of exterior shingles.
- Processing plant may have the potential to create 15 to 20 jobs.
- Study will identify all stamp sands in the area, mostly in Keweenaw County.
- Previous study provided statistical data, but did not provide a market study, start up costs or a business plan for building a production facility.
- Initial plan would be to sell the raw material, receive the money and then build a factory.

- Forty-five to seventy-five percent of the sands would be used for shingles. The rest could be used for other building materials.
- EPA has not identified any environmental issues with removing the stamp sands.
- Study will take approximately six months to complete. No guarantee factory will be located in Keweenaw County.
- David Sundburg: Project would create good synergy with Brownfield.

MOTION, Don Secor, supported by Ned Huwatschek, to recommend to the Keweenaw County Board of Commissioners an allocation of \$12, 500.00 from the Economic Development Fund for the feasibility study as proposed by WUPPDR.
